Knowledge and Experience

- This position requires a high school degree or GED, plus one year's experience in the hardscaping field.
- Candidate must be able to read and write.
- The successful individual will have a working knowledge of standard construction practices, basic understanding of electricity and basic piping and plumbing concepts.
- Strong oral and written communication skills, math skills, job planning skills, and mechanical aptitude are a must.

Certifications

This position requires that the individual be certified and licensed as follows:

- Obtaining a Basic Level Contractor Certification (ICPI) within one year of accepting this position.
- Commercial Driver's License (CDL)
- First aid / cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR)

Work Environment

Physical Demands

The physical demands outlined are examples of the type of demands the employee will encounter on the job site.

Job Site Conditions
